All shoots start at 8:30, unless otherwise specified.



The Appleseed Program is designed to take you from simply being a rifle owner to being a true Rifleman. All throughout American history, the Rifleman has been defined as a marksman capable of hitting targets from 500 yards away! This 500-yard range is traditionally known as "the rifleman's quarter-mile." A rifleman can hit just about any target he can see.

Learn the "Six steps to firing the shot." Learn correct firing positions and proper use of the sling.  
Hear some little-known Revolutionary War history and reaffirm your heritage.  
Become a more influential citizen and make America a better place.

### What you should bring:

A desire to learn and improve.  
A rifle (and a spare, if you have it)  
Ammunition: at least 500 rounds per day  
Scope OK. Sling strongly recommended.  
Eye and ear protection. Mat or ground cloth.  
Water, lunch, snacks.  
Some friends!

### What you can expect:

New Shooters - learn fundamentals and make quick progress.  
Experienced Shooters - learn techniques to tighten your groups.  
Expert Shooters – polish your shooting AND teaching skills.  
Everyone – expect to have a great time!

Registration Fees (per person): \$45 for one day or \$70 for both days. Women: \$5 for one day or \$10 for both days. Under 21: \$2.50 for one day or \$5 for both days. Active Military, Reserve, and Guard w/ ID, Peace Officers (w/ ID), Disabled (w/ ID), Re-enactors in period dress, Elected officials (w/proof) shoot for free!  
Registration fees do not include separate range fees which vary by location. Check at [www.appleseedinfo.org](http://www.appleseedinfo.org) for details.

There will be a host range fee of \$5 per shooter per day.

*Attendees are responsible for determining applicable firearms laws of the host state and for travel.  
Per NYS law, no one under the age of 12 years may fire a rifle at this event.*

No loaded firearms on the range unless on the firing line and load command has been given. Eye and ear protection required. Range has 50 covered outdoor firing points and a maximum of 200 yds for KD shooting. As with all Appleseed events, this is primarily a 25 meter event with some KD instruction/shooting on day two for those who are equipped and ready.

### Directions – GPS: 43.416341,-73.626052

**From points North, West & South:** From Adirondack Northway (I-87) take Exit 19. East on Quaker Rd (Aviation Rd). About 1.5 miles and turn left onto Ridge Rd (Rte. 9L North), we are approx. 7 miles on the right, #2080 Ridge Road.

**From points East:** US 7 to Exit 4 (Depot St/VT11 & 30). Turn toward Manchester Center, appx 1.5 mi. Continue on VT 30 northward appx. 21 mi then left onto VT 149. VT 149 becomes NY 149/E Main St. Continue on 149 through Granville, bearing left on 149/Quaker St.; after .8 mi 149 turns sharp right (w/ County Rd 146 on left). Continue west on 149 appx 10.5 mi, then left onto NY 40/149. Continue southward on 40 appx .4 mi, then right onto NY 149. Continue on 149 appx 10 mi, then turn left at Ann Street in Fort Ann. Continue 7.3 mi, then right at North Ridge Rd (NY 9L). Follow N. Ridge Rd. about 1.3 mi. Dunham's Bay Fish and Game will be on the right.
