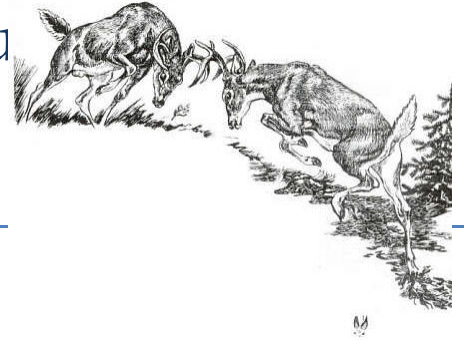


Dunham's Bay Fish & Game Club

The Dunham's Bay Fish & Game Club is conveniently located just off exit 19 of Interstate 87 in the Town of Queensbury, just minutes from the heart of dining, shopping and world-class tourism that the scenic Queensbury-Lake George region is famous for!

Directions: From Exit 19 off Interstate 87, take right onto Quaker Road (Aviation) Road. Follow for about 2.5 miles and go left onto Ridge Road (9L North), go approximately 7 miles North to 2080 Ridge Road. On the right is the Club.

We offer an excellent outdoor shooting range (Pistol, Rifle and Shot Gun) with 50 benches under a covered roof (you never have to wait for a bench!) and a 200 yard range considered one of the area's finest!

We have an indoor Archery and Pellet Range as well as an outdoor Archery and 3D Range.

DUE TO INSURANCE REGULATIONS ALL NEW MEMBERS MUST ATTEND A CLUB & RANGE ORIENTATION SESSION BEFORE THEIR APPLICATION IS PROCESSED, 2010 GATE COMBINATION AND OR CLUB HOUSE PASS KEY WILL BE ISSUED. The sessions will be approximately ½ hour in length.

Join us Membership Application for the Year 2010

Thank you for your interest in the Dunham's Bay Fish & Game Club! Annual membership runs from January 1st to Dec 31st.

Dues are set in November and due by Dec 31st of each year, *at the latest!* (Dues subject to change over time.) Anyone not paid by Dec 31st will be removed from the membership roster and have to rejoin (loss of tenure and must also re-pay the Initiation Fee). *New members (not previous members) who join after July 1st will be charged half the annual due's amount in addition to the initiation fee.*

CLUB MEETINGS: 2nd Wednesday of each month at 7:30 SHARP! Attendance is suggested but not required.

Membership Types

- GENERAL MEMBERSHIP: \$100 per year. You will receive full membership rights and privileges including gate access, full range access, membership card and button and voting privilege. This membership includes you and your immediate family (spouse and dependent children 21 and under). Only the primary member whose name is on the membership roster may vote. Must be at least 18 yrs of age to join.
- SENIOR MEMBERSHIP: \$75.00 per year. You will receive full membership rights and privileges including gate access, full range access, membership card and button and voting privilege. This membership includes you and your immediate family (spouse and dependent children 21 and under). Only the primary member whose name is on the membership roster may vote. Must be age 60 or over (I.D.Required).

INITIATION FEE: This is a \$25 fee that is payable along with your application and first year's dues. It helps to cover administration costs associated with adding a new member to the roster etc.

Club Rules

- Club facilities are for use by paid members and their guests. Members are responsible for the behavior of their guests.
- There are to be no alcoholic beverages consumed on Club property.
- A member's guest may come to the Club free of charge once per year, (Have them read the posted Rules.)
- Substantial charges of serious violations of the fish and game laws, un-sportsmanlike conduct, or conduct detrimental to the Club or contrary to Club rules and regulations will mandate expulsion from the Club.
- Range maintenance takes precedence over all shooting. If range maintenance is being performed, the range will be closed until it is completed.
- **DUE TO INSURANCE REGULATIONS ALL NEW MEMBERS *(and) SHOOTING FAMILY MEMBERS MUST ATTEND A CLUB & RANGE ORIENTATION SESSION BEFORE 2010 GATE AND CLUB HOUSE PASS KEY WILL BE ISSUED.** Class dates will be posted on the web site, members will be required to register so as to control session size.

Best Practice Guidelines

- Introduce yourself to fellow members while at the Range.
- Agree to use the following commands: ceasefire, range clear (**clear to proceed down Range**) and commence fire.
- Act professionally and *think safety!* Watch your Muzzle discipline.
- Keep the Range clean. If you don't reload, place your empty brass in the coffee cans. THIS INCLUDES YOUR .22 SHELL CASINGS!
- Please display your Club Pin on your person or gear while on the Club grounds.

Range Rules

1. All shooters and spectators shall wear eye and ear protection when on the firing range.
2. The shooting range is open to members daily. Shooting hours are 9AM until ½ hour **before** legal sunset.
3. Scheduled matches and activities (and Range maintenance) will take precedence over informal shooting and the range will be closed unless authorized by the event director.
4. **Never go down range until a cease-fire has been called and all firearms have been made safe!**
5. Always keep firearms pointed in a safe direction (downrange).
6. **Do not handle your firearm on the firing line if anyone is downrange! When anyone is downrange all firearms must be open, unloaded, and in safe condition and placed on a bench or otherwise safely positioned. Step back from the bench and DO NOT TOUCH ANYTHING ON THE BENCH!**
7. No person shall be permitted on the range who is under the influence of drugs or alcohol, or whose behavior is not conducive to their safety or the safety of others.
8. Children are not permitted on or near the range unless they are under the direct supervision of their parents and are old enough to comprehend and obey all instructions and safety rules.
9. Possession and handling of firearms on club property is to be governed by all applicable federal, state and local laws.
10. The use of rocks, glass bottles, cement blocks or other dangerous materials as targets is forbidden. Do not shoot at the target support pipes (100 yard line), the wood target support poles (25,50,75 & 100 yard line's) or the well head berm. Any one caught vandalizing or destroying club property will be subject to expulsion from the Club and or prosecution.
11. The club does not supply target materials for informal shooting or target practice. Members and their guests must supply their own targets and target stands. Members and their guests shall clean up the Range and ALL THEIR SPENT CASINGS after they are finished shooting. (Recycle your brass please.)
